

BAGGUNDI LAKE - WATER BODY RESURGENCE

Baggundi Lake an 80 acres water reservoir between Baikampady village & Kulai village close to NH 66 is the source of water for these two villages and surrounding areas.

Baggundi name has been derived from Babbu Gundi. There is a Daivasthana in Kulai village called Koteda Babbu. There is a tradition of catching fish by the villagers on the day of annual festival of Daivasthana which falls on 14 March (Meena Sankramana day). On that day early morning at 7 A.M, pyrotechs called Kadhoni is burst infront of Daivasthana to mark the beginning of the festival . Soon thereafter villagers will jump into the Baggundi Lake to catch fish. They used to get bountiful fish, which is cooked for the noon meals, the same day

Baggundi lake is unique in its ecosystem with varieties of Flora & Fauna with lot of birds visiting the lake at different seasons of the year. For the last several years, the villagers are disappointed because they are not able to get any fish in the Baggundi lake and there are no birds in the vicinity flying around the lake. Lake is filled with weeds and silt

River through Kudumbur River. During high tide, river water flows into the Lake and during low tide it used to flow out. As a result, the Lake was getting cleansed and

was a breeding place for fish. In recent times, after the road & railway bridges were constructed over Kudumbur river, the water flow got blocked and the Lake was disconnected from the Falguni River. Also, monsoon drain connection to this lake has started carrying the domestic & industrial waste into the lake. As a result, the lake is totally polluted at present. Due to this breeding of fish has also stopped.

Kanara Industries Association (KIA) had taken the initiative to develop this lake as a picnic cum tourist destination since 2012.

We have contacted major Industries around New Mangalore Port area seeking their CSR fund and have received positive response.

KIA is in constant touch with local representatives, Government and NGO'S to carryout lake redevelopment. Shramadhan, was one of our initiatives to clean the Lake. Originally the lake was of 13

Acre area. Now it has grown big covering an area of about 80 Acres.

In the meanwhile, Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board (KIADB), which is the nodal agency for providing land for industry has acquired the land around the lake and including the lake this land has been with JESCO.

In this context, members of KIA along with representatives of KIADB had a meeting with Shri Anand Malligavad to understand his way of rejuvenating lakes. He has rejuvenated 23 lakes so far. He is confident



that the Lake can be revived by developing it in a natural way. Desilting is carried out and the lake is dug till we get the original soil and this soil is used to build the lake without any stone/ tile. Pavements, bunds and walkway can be constructed using the excess soil recovered from the bed of the lake. The Bank of the lake is leveled with the soil available and walking/ jogging track, garden, lawn, benches etc. will be provided. There is also a proposal to treat the water which is being fed to the baggundi lake now, alongside the lake. KIA will look for
