

# **Ensuring Safety in MSME's: A Collective Cause**

The MSME sector, a vital pillar of India's economy, employs over 120 million individuals, contributing significantly to both manufacturing and service sectors—around 6% and 25% of GDP, respectively. However, a pressing concern shadows this success: a notably high occurrence of workplace injuries and fatalities.

According to the International Labour Organization (ILO), a worker meets with a work-related accident or illness every 15 seconds, with 153 others enduring injuries within that timeframe. This trend is amplified in MSMEs, often constrained by limited resources. The cost of overlooking health and safety is steep—India recorded about 4.4 million occupational injuries in 2019, with a tragic 43,000 lives lost. This toll translated to a staggering ₹200 billion in productivity loss. Beyond immediate effects, this tarnishes an MSME's reputation, impacting its customer and employee retention.

In the MSME sectors, a unique challenge emerges: Balancing safety practices with comfort and productivity. A behavioural issue where there is worker's reluctance to change and owners' immediate productivity focus. MSMEs can bridge this gap by encouraging a safety-first culture





through focused training, incentives, and shared responsibilities. The safety culture concept is grown and is absorbed by the people in the organization through constant interference and amendments of safety policies. By showcasing the interconnectedness of safety and productivity, businesses empower workers and owners to navigate this shared success factor.

Data from the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) highlights the strategic nature of safety investments. Every dollar invested yields \$4 to \$6 in returns. Preventing accidents trims medical expenses, workers' compensation claims, and insurance premiums and most importantly, owners' peace of mind. A secure work environment curbs property damage and equipment failures, yielding savings on repairs and replacements.

Another data suggests that machineries with older technology requires skilled labour, thereby increasing the chances of accidents. As employees grow older, and if the work requires a very high level of precision, the risk becomes higher. Injuries such as thumb and leg injury, and some minor cuts are common. Most of the newer technology machineries comes with built

in safety features. Upgrading to newer technology is always a better option both in terms of safety and productivity.

Government Support: The government also plays a role in enhancing health and safety in MSMEs. ESI for workers is mandatory, which can be considered a boon on its own. The government also extends financial aid for implementing safety measures and enforcing regulations. Programs encompass Administering Road Safety, ISO 9001/14001 certification reimbursements, etc. among others. These efforts fortify the sector's safety landscape.
